1. The attention of the Collectors in the state is invited to the subject and references cited. In the reference last cited circular instructions along with Model Notification for both V.R.O and V.R.A., posts were issued wherein it is mentioned that Examination fee is Rs.200/- for both V.R.O and V.R.A posts. There is no mention of the Service charge to be paid to the Service Providers.

2. The Model Notification sent to you does not contain anything about the Service charge payable by the applicant. It is decided that the candidates have to pay Rs.20/- to the Service Providers (e-Seva, Mee-Seva, APonline) towards application processing Fee i.e., for filling up of application online, making payment online, giving printed receipt. The same may be inserted at appropriate place i.e. at item No. 5 of Annexure-I and Annexure-II. The Notification with this inserted provision shall be got published in the local daily news paper.

3. The Collectors must also ensure that the Service Provider shall not charge more than Rs.20/- from any candidate for one application. The examination fee as well as service charges must be collected by way of cash.

Sub: Direct Recruitment of Village Revenue Officers & Village Revenue Assistants in the State – Instructions on arriving of vacancies on Pro rata basis in descending order – Clarification – Issued.

The attention of the Collectors is invited to the subject and references cited. It may be noted that the Government had permitted to fill up approximately 75% of the vacancies of the Village Revenue Assistants. A question has been raised as to the procedure for allocation of the sanctioned posts to different Mandals and Villages. The following instructions are issued in this regard:

1. The number of posts allocated to be filled in each District may be at first distributed among the Mandals in proportion to the number of vacancies existing in the Mandal;
2. Next, one post each shall be allocated to those Villages where there is not a single Village Revenue Assistant working at present and all the posts are vacant;
3. The balance number of posts may be allocated to the Villages in proportion to the number of vacancies existing. For this purpose, the Villages in the Mandal may be arranged in the descending order of number of vacancies, after taking into consideration the posts allocated in step (2) above. The fractions may be rounded off to the nearest higher/lower integer while computing and allocating the vacancies.
